


## Tips for Using Adobe 11.0.10

For Grants.gov applications in .pdf format, use Adobe Reader 11.0.10 (Adobe XI). All applications must be opened, completed, reviewed, and submitted with the same version of Adobe Reader- Version 11.0.10




### Uninstall previous versions of Adobe Reader:

Open the Control Panel under the Start Menu.

Select “Programs and Features” (Windows 7) OR “Add or Remove Programs” (Windows XP).

The software can be downloaded for free from the Adobe Website.

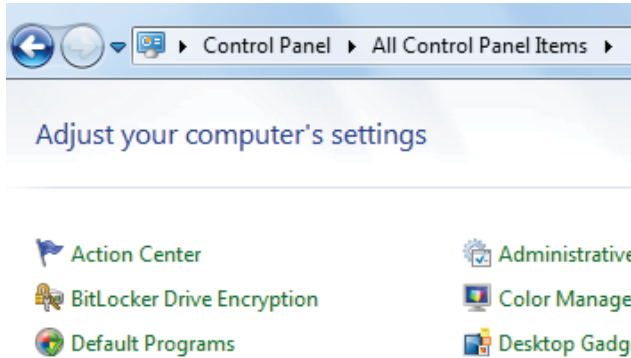

## Make Adobe Reader 11.0.10 your default program to open Adobe files:

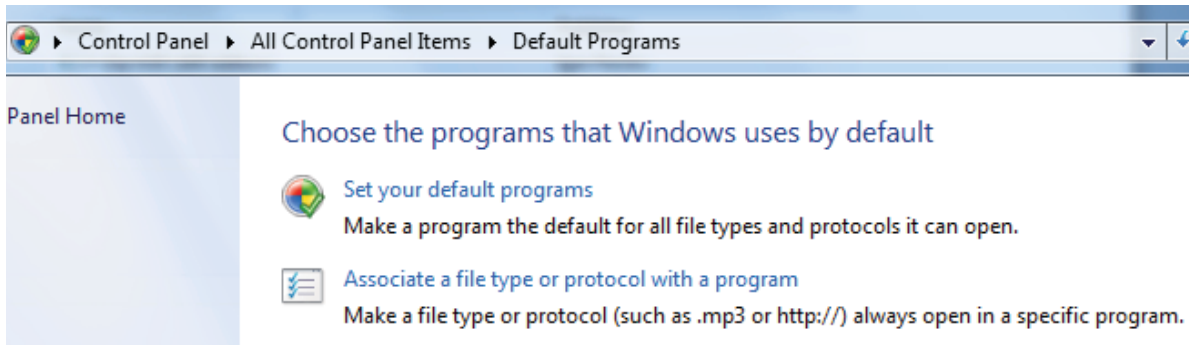
If given the option during installation and set up, select Adobe Reader 11.0.10 as the default to open .pdf files.

If you have both Adobe Professional or other .pdf generating programs AND Adobe Reader on your computer, make sure that Adobe Reader 11.0.10 is set as the default program to open .pdf files.

Open the Control Panel under the Start Menu.



Under Default Programs, choose “Associate a file type with a specific program”.



Find “.pdf” and make sure it says “Adobe Reader”.
