The RPPR is specifically for research awards and its content is in accordance with the requirements for Non-Federal entity submission of performance reports as outlined in OMB-approved Government-wide standard information collections, per 2 CFR Part 200, §200.328.

Recipients must complete the RPPR directly in Grants Online, NOAA's electronic grants management system. The RPPR must be used for all fiscal year 2019 research awards and awards in succeeding fiscal years. Additionally, requirement of its use will be included as a Special Condition to all awards with a start date prior to October 1, 2018.
