

NASA NSPIRES Registration Information

Who needs to be a registered member in NSPIRES?

Any individual needs to have an active membership if he/she wishes to perform the following actions:

- Create or submit an NOI
- Create or submit a proposal (to either NSPIRES or Grants.gov)
- Serve as a team member on either an NOI or a proposal (to either NSPIRES or Grants.gov)

You do not need to be a member to find and read proposal opportunities or to see information about past, funded proposals.

How do I start my registration in NSPIRES?

Go to the NSPIRES Home page at <http://nspires.nasaprs.com/external/>, and click the Registration Information link in the blue "Member Login" box. Fill out the requested information, add an affiliation with UMCP, and follow the instructions in the email you receive from NSPIRES.

What is an affiliation?

An affiliation is a business relationship between an NSPIRES registered member and an organization's Sponsored Research Office (SRO, or equivalent). An affiliation must be requested by a member of an organization and confirmed by the SRO. A member cannot submit a proposal to NASA without having a confirmed affiliation.

When you add an affiliation with the University of Maryland, you can search by the UEI: NPU8ULVAAS23.
